Submitted by October 15 and April 15.

Students may receive this award once per academic year, with a priority to applicants who haven't received the award previously.

Recipient Selection:

Selection is based on the application and financial need as indicated by application documents. Selection will be determined by the GSA Awards Committee based on deadlines noted above.
